Origin

The Knights of Columbus was founded by Fr. Michael McGivney in 1882 @ St. Mary's parish in New Haven, Connecticut. Fr. McGivney and 12 parishioners saw a need for an organization to serve the Church, Parish Community, and to help widows and orphans.

Basic Principles
